會長的話：

是一個由 Ray Barkalow 已註冊的種植方法，植物生長三大特性是向光性、向地性和向水性誘變陸生植物的根長出水生根，等長出水生根後，便可再轉至水耕種植。

基本上所用的盆只是一個透明或半透明的膠杯或膠筒，膠杯或膠筒底是沒排水孔，只有兩個排水孔在膠杯邊離杯底 2cm 左右，植材是陶粒 (發泡煉石約 1cm~1.5cm 直徑)或混合粗的白蘭石，使用的陶粒表面要粗，這樣會使陶粒空隙增加，空氣就容易進出。而空氣進出是靠熱力升華及微細孔作用，所以植材最好選用吸水性強的陶粒和白蘭石，還有不用考慮根的粗幼，而使用較細直徑的陶粒。

### 甚麼是半水耕種植法？

- 採用無機介質
- 盆是一個透明或半透明的杯狀容器，下方的五分之一處開兩個排水孔
- 陶粒內的水因吸熱而升華，使空氣走進盆內
- 陶粒又因微細孔作吸收盆底儲水庫的水
- 水位下降空氣又再有機會走進去
- 誘變陸生植物的根長出水生根

### 益處

- 使用後發根和活根的數量會增加，出芽及開花率也高了
- 解決種植環境低濕度問題
- 澆水容易得多 - 不用常常澆水，但亦可以每天澆水
- 大部份蘭類植物也能用 (當然不是全部)

### 介質

採用較不會腐壞的偏中性有孔無機材質:

- 使用的介質顆粒直徑約一公分左右
- 因為溫度的蒸散作用和毛細孔作用，顆粒狀介質的間隙能讓空氣流通，使蘭花的根系不易腐壞
- 例如陶粒，蘭石，珍珠石以及碳 (也可以混用)
- 用陶粒前泡水一天

### 管理

- 半水耕法的管理非常簡易，只要維持水位不要全乾即可，澆水時，可堵住排水孔將介質全浸濕，或多澆些水讓介質全濕
- 在蘭花生長期間，可每兩星期澆花肥溶液。如果耕種介質發生白色積鹽現象，可使用較大容器加水浸泡一兩小時，將化肥堆積鹽溶解沖掉，即可繼續種植，不需更換介質
- 每隔一段時間用乾淨的水沖滿儲水庫 (flush)，以溶解多餘肥料及積鹽

- 高濕度種法 - 節水才能開花的石斛，在冬天仍不能讓 S/H 完全乾枯，替代以不施肥來達成逆境，也可開花

## 用盆

- 小苗用小盆，大株用大盆一向是正確的，只要根的大小能植入盆就可以
- 不用大盆主要原因是避免植料太濕以致爛根
- 半水耕法下在同樣的情況，盆大一點也不是問題

## 如何準備植盆

- 容器 - 塑膠杯面的孔洞不要開太高，大約距離底部 1.5cm 就可以，當然開高一點，水儲多一點就不用常常加水，所以又有人稱它為” 懶人栽種法”

## 如何換盆

- 種植時，先將介質填充至容器的排水孔以上如右圖，以免太多的根部長期浸水造成不必要的病變
- 剛種時從上方常常灌水，好讓容器內的植材完全濕透，多餘的水會從下方排水孔排掉
- 一段時間沖一次乾淨的水
- Nobile type 石斛蘭不用制水，不施肥即可

- 拖鞋蘭 (Paphiopedilum)
- 南美拖鞋蘭(Phragmipedium)
- 蝴蝶蘭 (Phalaenopsis)
- 石斛蘭 (Dendrobium)
- 國蘭(蕙蘭) (Cymbidium)
- 文心蘭 (Oncidium)
- 嘉德利雅 (Cattleya)

## 哪一品種並不推薦用半水耕種植法？

- 版狐尾蘭 (Rhyconstylis)
- 萬代屬 (Vanda & all Vandeous hybrids and intergenerics)
- 豆蘭 (Bulbophyllum)
- 一般已種植上的個體

## 壞處

白色粉是鹽積，可能你澆的花水是硬水或施肥濃度高，有機會和陶粒有離子交換，但這不是問題，只要用減少施肥多沖水沖走鹽積,陶粒能保持微濕就不會傷根

- 部份底葉會黃化
- 部份舊根會爛掉
- 陶粒全乾後有鹽積
- 用透明膠盆會長綠藻
- 經陽光暴曬後,透明膠盆容易硬化變脆弱易爛

### 蘭展守則

本會 2007 年度蘭展將於 4 月 14 及 15 日假大多倫多中華文化中心舉行，歡迎會員借出蘭花在本會攤位上展出，但希望有關會員能遵守下列規則：

- 1) 借出之蘭花請先修飾妥當，例如把殘花、老枝、壞葉、枯根等剪去，清潔葉面，如有蟲害，必先要清除；花枝需支撐者先用竹枝支撐好。
- 2) 把蘭花擁有者 / 提供者的名字及聯絡電話號碼寫在花盆上。
- 3) 請於**4 月 13 日正午 12 時至下午 3 時**把蘭株帶到中華文化中心地下展覽場交予蘭展登記處。遲交者將由蘭展負責人決定能否參予展出及評審。由於此日並非展覽日，交花後請即離開會場。
- 4) 借出之蘭花，將由蘭展負責人作篩選及展出，但亦有可能不能參展，原因如下：
  - a) 蘭花有病、蟲害、病毒等
  - b) 蘭花型態、花數、株體大小、健康情況等被認為未達展出水準
  - c) 會員提供的蘭花總株數過多，地方不足
  - d) 蘭花品種相同，觀賞價值較差者可能被淘汰
  - e) 被禁制入口之蘭花( 除非能提供合法來源證明)
  - f) 過時提交蘭株
- 5) 借出蘭株在攤位擺放位置由本會決定
- 6) 借出之蘭株本會將小心照料，但本會絕不保證其安全。蘭株若有損傷或遺失，本會恕不負責。
- 7) 在展覽攤位之蘭株，除非獲得蘭展負責人同意，否則在展覽會結束前任何人不能拿走。
- 8) 借出蘭花者跟其他本會會員及公眾人仕一樣，在進入展覽廳參觀時必須付費。
- 9) 借出蘭花者請準時於**4 月 15 日下午 5 時 15 分**展覽完畢後到本會攤位向負責人取回蘭株。無人認領之蘭株本會將暫時代為保管及嘗試聯絡借出蘭株者，但其間本會不能負責其安全。
- 10) 歡迎會員寄賣蘭花，每天限量 30 盆，同時必須準備售賣蘭花種類、價格及寫上會員姓名及編號，一式兩份在 14 或 15 日展覽時交到負責人張素珊女士處理；有關擺放位置一概由本會負責人決定，會員不可異議。有關售賣成交後，本會將收取賣出總數 10%作為服務費。同時，本會不會負責閣下寄賣蘭花之安全。

本屆蘭展將加入美國蘭花協會評審，參加評審的蘭株需為帶花株。依規定展出之蘭花若能獲獎，登記展出者需向該會繳交評審費為美金\$55 及攝影費\$40。為鼓勵更多會員提供優質蘭花在本會攤位展出，本會決定代借出蘭株者繳付上述費用，但借出蘭花者必需為本會會員及所用登記名字跟在蘭會申請表上名字相同。獲獎花株及獎項將由提供蘭株會員保存。

**S/H culture is developed by Ray Barkalow in the U.S. Plants are grown towards: 1) light; 2) ground (through gravity) and 3) moisture. In S/H culture, roots are being attracted towards the water. These newly developed roots are “water roots” which will grow submerge 100% in water (composition of cell within the roots are very different than aerial roots).**

**Container used is a clear or semi-clear cup, with reservoir at the bottom 1/5 of the container. Medium is clay pellets (that has been fired in extremely high temperature at 3000°C range) through capillary action, moisture wicked upward and root zone is kept moist, but not soaking wet.**

### **What is Semi-Hydroponics Culture?**

- Use inorganic media
- Growing container is a clear or semi-clear cup, with reservoir at the bottom 1/5 of the container.
- Holes are drilled on the side of the container to ensure consistent water level in the reservoir
- Clay pellets are used as medium
- Through capillary action, clay pellets will wick water up from the reservoir to supply moisture to the root zone
- Evaporation will also ensure moisture in the root zone
- New roots are attracted and grown towards water

### **Benefits**

- A lot more roots activity and less rotten roots once established
- More new growths
- Flower more frequently
- Solve low humidity issue (growing at home)
- Easy watering - cannot over-water
- Can be used with most orchid genera

### **Media**

- Inorganic media with rough surface and high absorption ratio
- Due to the size and shape of the clay pellets, air can circulate through the root zone—decrease the chance of rotted roots
- Can be mixed with perlite, charcoal, lava rocks or other inorganic media
- Soak at least 24 hours before use to maximize performance

### **Maintenance**

- Ensure reservoir is not empty, water when necessary (or when you feel like it!)
- Can also cover the holes on the side and soak the medium totally
- During active growth, fertilizer every two weeks. If white deposit appears on the surface of the clay pellets, use a larger container and soak the entire pot. This will solve the salt accumulation on the surface of the clay pellets.
- Flush the pot using R/O or rainwater every few weeks to ensure excess fertilizer and salt are out of the reservoir.

## **Size of the container**

- In traditional growing culture, always err on the side of using a smaller pot
- Media in a larger pot takes longer to dry out, roots are more prone to rot.
- In S/H culture, since the reservoir is in a constant level, size of pot is not as critical.
- Remember, you can never over water in S/H culture!

## **Tips**

- When first repotted to S/H culture, water as often as you can to ensure media on the top portion of the pot remain moist
- Flush the media every few weeks
- Nobile-type Dendrobiums do need the total dry out period in S/H culture, simply withhold fertilizer and the plant will flower

## **Orchid genera that will do well in S/H culture**

- Paphiopedilum
- Phragmipedium
- Phalaenopsis
- Dendrobium
- Cymbidium
- Oncidium
- Cattleya

## **Orchid genera that are not recommended for S/H culture**

- Rhyconstylis
- Vanda & all Vandeous hybrids and intergenerics
- Bulbophyllum
- Mounted specimen

## **Things to watch out for**

- When first transplanted into S/H culture, the bottom leaves of most plant will turn brown and fall off
- Most of the old roots will rot
- If clay pellets are dried, salt will accumulate on the surface
- Algae growth in pots

### Orchid Show Regulations

2007 annual TAOA Orchid Show will be held on April 14 & 15 at the Chinese Cultural Centre. We welcome members to loan their plants for display in our show. We would appreciate it very much if members can observe the following regulations:

- 1) Plants should be trimmed off all wilted flowers, old stems, dead roots and leaves. Plants should be cleaned and free from pest and disease. Wobbly plants should be held steady and tied to support.
- 2) Label the plant owner's or contributor's name and contact telephone number on the pot.
- 3) Bring plants to the Chinese Cultural Centre of Greater Toronto, ground level exhibition room to TAOA person-in-charge on **April 13 from 12:00–3:00 pm**. Plants arrive later than the above-mentioned hours may not be exhibited or judged. As this is not a show day, please leave immediately after you have handed in your plants.
- 4) TAOA will try to exhibit as many plants as possible, but plants may not be selected for the following reasons:
  - a) Plants have pests or disease
  - b) The quality of plants do not meet the standard for exhibition
  - c) Our show table could not accommodate all the plants
  - d) For plants with the same name the one of lower quality will be eliminated
  - e) Plants forbidden to enter the country (except with legal permit)
  - f) Plants brought in late
- 5) Where plants are placed is determined by TAOA.
- 6) TAOA will not be responsible for injured or stolen plants.
- 7) Plants are not allowed to be removed from the show table before the show is over, unless TAOA agrees.
- 8) Members who loan out plants do not enjoy special privilege. They have to pay admission fee as other members and the general public.
- 9) On **April 15 at 5:15 pm** when the show is over, please come to claim your plants. Plants unclaimed will be kept by TAOA. Owner of plants will be contacted but TAOA is not responsible for their safety.
- 10) Member's sales table – all members are welcome to bring their plants for sale, each member cannot bring more than 30 plants each day and 10% service charge will be in place. Please list your name, member's number, plants name and price (2 copies) deliver to TAOA member's sales table person in charge (Ms. Susan Cheung). She will arrange all sales procedures and TAOA is not responsible for their safety.

The upcoming TAOA Orchid Show will include AOS Judging. Plants for AOS Judging must be in bloom. According to AOS Judging regulation, award winners must pay judging fee of USD55 and photography fee of USD40. In order to encourage more members to participate and enter their high quality plants for our show table, TAOA will pay the above-mentioned fee. Those who loan out plants must be TAOA members and their name must be the same as the name registered on their membership application form. The awarded plant and prize will be kept by the owner.
