### 2007年 11月份通訊

各位會員蘭友：

11月17日是本會兩年一次的「幹事改選」的日子，請各會員推選心目中人選或自我推薦，加入幹事行列，為推動華人蘭會事務貢獻一份力量。幹事會議一般在每次例會後（即單月份第三個星期六）開會，地點同樣在「中華文化中心」內。

**\*\*\* 選舉在 17 日例會開始時，每位出席會員將獲分派「候選會員名單」乙份，請各位在每份名單上圈出或用 (√) 號選出最多十名候選人，但如果推舉超過此限定人數之選票，將被視作廢票，敬請各位留意。例會後幹事會將點算所有得選票者數目，以首 25 位獲得票數最多者加入幹事會；敬請各位會員蘭友踴躍出席，參與選舉。\*\*\***

踏入 11 月份後氣溫明顯轉涼，尤其晚間氣溫已跌至單位數字，相信各蘭友早已將蘭花移入室內，但之前的殺蟲工作是否足夠；故此必須多加細心檢查花卉，有否帶進一些殘留害蟲傷害蘭株，影響日後開花效果。秋冬季節澆水次數應較夏季減少，施肥濃度亦要減半，同時早晚溫度應有差距，讓蘭株感應溫度變化刺激花芽生長，並且注意室內因暖氣的啟動而令濕度降低，在日間可加添噴霧使濕度維持在最少 60% - 70%，祝各位蘭友的蘭花燦爛生長。

9 月份主講嘉賓陳大典先生，與各位分享種植國蘭心得，同時贈送有關種植國蘭書籍數本，本人代表蘭會多謝陳先生的慷慨送贈。有關書籍現已添加入本會圖書收藏中，請有興趣者在每次例會時借閱。

認識植物的生態環境：

- (1) 生命之源：水  
水質：軟水、硬水  
酸鹼度 (pH 值) 茶叶渣 (生物碱) 食用醋 (1%)
- (2) 澆水方法：植料種類、季節性、時間 (早、午、晚)
- (3) 空氣濕度
- (4) 生長適溫：四季 (秋)、墨蘭、寒蘭、送春、秋榜  
春蘭、九華、春劍、蓮瓣、豆瓣、虎頭蘭類
- (5) 日照：長短、光量
- (6) 養份：腐生 - 大根蘭、天麻、珊瑚蘭  
附生 - 日本春蘭、虎頭蘭類、東亞蘭  
地生 - 大部分國蘭
- (7) 養份來源：有機物、無機物  
肥料分析：大量元素、小量元素、微量元素
- (8) 食物製造過程：發生在含有色素的細胞內  
輔酶 (含鐵) + 光  
二氧化碳 + 水  $\xrightarrow{\text{催化作用}}$  碳水化合物 + 氧氣
- (9) 病蟲害
- (10) 開花機制

國蘭種植方法：

1. 春夏季，每天澆水，儘量在早上進行
2. 在施肥後，大量澆水，增加蘭根空氣氧份及沖走鹽份
3. 需要有蓋遮擋雨水以免對葉面的損傷
4. 時常保持空氣流通
5. 若在購買有葉藝之國蘭時，須留意新芽有否出現斑紋，有斑紋出現者，葉藝將會較明顯
6. 成熟蘭株必須在秋末冬初時制水，時間約 2 星期至 20 天，以便刺激花芽出現。

#### **2008-2009 Election**

Approaching November means cool weather coming, especially night temperatures will drop to single positive digits. Probably you have moved your orchids indoor. But did you check out for harmful bugs before doing so? You should also cut down the frequency of watering and reduce to half the concentration of fertilizers. Maintain a temperature difference between day and night will induce spike formation. Raise the humidity, if necessary, to at least 60-70%.

I wish to represent our society to thank Mr. 陳大典 for his talk on Chinese Cymbidium Culture and his donation of related books which have been added to our library.

To understand the ecological of plants : -

- 1) Source of life = water  
water quality = soft water, hard water  
alkalinity / acidity (ph value)  
tea leaf residue (to ↑ ph)  
cooking vinegar 1% (to ↓ ph)
- 2) Watering depends on : culture media  
season  
time of the day : morning, afternoon, evening.
- 3) Humidity
- 4) Optimum temperature: depends on the species
- 5) Sunshine : duration  
intensity
- 6) Nutrition : growing on humus  
epiphytes  
terrestrial: most Chinese Cymbidium belong to this group
- 7) Source of nutrient : Organic, inorganic  
Fertilizer analysis : macro element  
minute element  
micro element
- 8) Food production procedure : takes place inside cells with  
Chlorophyll and light  
$$6 \text{ CO}_2 \text{ (carbon dioxide)} + 6\text{H}_2\text{O (water)} \xrightarrow[\text{Co-enzyme (Fe)}]{\text{Chlorophyll and light}} \text{C}_6\text{H}_{12}\text{O}_6 \text{ (sugar)} + 6\text{O}_2 \text{ (oxygen)}$$
- 9) Bugs and insects
- 10) Mechanism of flowering

To cultivate Chinese Cymbidium

- 1) Spring and summer : water daily in the morning.
- 2) Copious watering after fertilizing to provide nourishment and to remove salt.
- 3) Protect from rain to prevent damage to leaves.
- 4) Ventilation important.
- 5) On purchasing Chinese Cymbidium with variegated leaves, look for new leaves with variegation. This will intensify as the leaves grow.
- 6) For mature plants, in order to induce spike formation, withhold water at late autumn and early winter.
